Access Permit to Brown Acre and Mount Campbell

I hereby acknowledge and accept that:

The land known as Brown Acre and Mount Campbell is privately owned and leased to Mount Campbell Networks Limited and the road is not a public road and is maintained at Mount Campbell Networks' own cost.

The road is a four wheel drive access road with deep open water cut-offs and is therefore not suitable for anything but four wheel drive vehicles with high ground clearances.

Parts of the land, installations and road are hazardous. These hazards are not individually indicated by signs.

I have read and understood the "Hazard Notification" and "Access Rules" and declare that I am not entering the land for commercial purposes.

NL & CE Wensley and Mount Campbell Networks Limited consent to my visiting the property only on the basis that it is entirely at my and any body in my groups' own risk and that I have accepted full responsibility for my, and others in my parties own safety and that NL & CE Wensley and Mount Campbell Networks Limited shall not be liable for any injury, damage or accident to person or property.

ATTACHMENT TO ACCESS PERMIT

HAZARD NOTIFICATION

Radio transmitting equipment installed on man-made structures may be emitting non-ionising radiation.

Keep away from all radio towers and man-made structures and under no circumstances climb these structures. Be aware of ice and other objects falling from structures.

Power cables have been surface laid and direct buried. These are operating at lethal voltages and should not be interfered with.

Roads are maintained to provide access for rugged four wheel drive vehicles with high ground clearances; SUV's (sports utility vehicles) and all wheel drive road vehicles are not suitable for this access road and should not be used. The depth of water run-off ditches across and beside the road may not be apparent.

ACCESS RULES

DO NOT USE THE ROAD IF IT IS RAINING OR HAS RAINED IN THE PREVIOUS 48 HOURS (you may walk).

Engage low gear ratio and four-wheel-drive at the sign "Steep Grade 4wheel drive only".

Lock the gate after you. Do not allow any other party through the gate while it is opened by you.

Do not take rocks, vegetation shrubs, animal life or any other item from the land.

Do not discard rubbish or food scrapes and use the toilet facilities provided.

Do not light fires.

No hunting, camping or use of firearms.

No smoking under any circumstances including in vehicles.

Carry a portable fire extinguisher, first aid kit and shovel.

Do not leave parked vehicles in a position to block access of other vehicles.

Do not speed and be aware that walkers, mountain bikers and other vehicles may be using the road at any time of day or night (water run-off ditches are deep – approach with caution).

The land is remote and at high altitude and adverse weather conditions can be encountered at any time – be prepared.

Report any and all identified hazards and potential risks (phone Lloyd Wensley 021 438 120).

Take a means of communication in case of emergency and let someone responsible know when you expect to return.

No pets or animals are to be taken to the property. All stray domestic animals will be impounded where possible, otherwise destroyed on site.

You must obtain neighbours permission before entering their properties.

This Access Permit is not transferable and may be revoked at any time verbally or otherwise by NL & CE Wensley, Mount Campbell Networks Limited or their staff or representative.

ACCESS TO MOUNT CAMPBELL

Take State Highway 61 (turn towards the hills at the Clock Tower) from Motueka and cross the Alexandra Bluff bridge to the west bank of the Motueka River, 12km up from Motueka.

Follow the west bank road downstream about 200 metres to Rocky River and turn left up Rocky River Road.

Go straight ahead at the intersection (2km), remaining on Rocky River Road.

Cross two fords.

At the intersection (6km), go straight ahead (don't go down Trig Road).

At the crossroads (7km), turn left and take Stillwells Road.

Stillwells Road bears left (7km – 8km), go straight ahead up Mount Campbell Road. Select four-wheel drive (put chains on all four wheels if there has been lots of rain or snow on the ground). The next 200 metres are the most slippery of the track. At the locked gate (9km) you enter private property. **This gate must be left locked at all times.**

Pass the land mobile sites.
